Long Island Iced Tea - 12.50

This cocktail is believed to have been birthed during the 1920's prohibition as the "perfectly camouflaged" alcoholic beverage. Originally made with sugar syrup before Coca-Cola.

Classic - vodka, gin, tequila, rum, triple sec & Coca Cola

Kentucky Tea - made with bourbon and syrup

Neon Tea - made with blue curaçao

Mediterranean - made with amaretto & orange juice.

Daiquiri - 12.00

This cocktail has an interesting connection to war. Invented by an American engineer in Cuba during the American-Spanish War, it was also highly popular in the 1940's, as rum was the most obtainable liquor during wartime rationing.

Classic - Rum, lime juice & sugar syrup

Strawberry - made with strawberries

Mediterranean - made with orange and cranberry juice & grenadine

Cosmopolitan - 12.00

This cocktail has become a classic amongst mixed drinks - becoming greatly popular during the 90's from being mentioned so much in popular culture.

Classic - citrus vodka, triple sec, lime & cranberry juice

Raspberry - made with raspberry liqueur

Dirty Cosmo - made with tequila and agave nectar

Mediterranean - made with amaretto & orange juice.
