Kids will get a thrill comparing their footprints with that of dinosaurs that roamed the land over 68 million years ago. **Dinosaur Ridge** is just 15 minutes outside of the city and has 100s of tracks to explore and even the bones of a Stegosaurus and Brontosaurus.
